Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of
1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Copper Canyon Mining Company
Post-office address Battle Mountain, Lander County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.01 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 12th, 1919

Description of works of diversion and use:-
Water is conserved in a tunnel and diverted into a 3/4"
pipe and conveyed to a small garden 26' x 80' located in the SE
part SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 30 T. 32 N.R. 44 E., MDB&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed
the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which
acquired.
