CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Eva May Griffeth has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Badger Creek

through Badger Creek ditch for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW Cor. SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 2, T. 39 N.R. 52 E. M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Eva May Griffeth

Post-office address Tuscarora, Elko County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 1.2627 cubic feet of water per second, or 378.81 acre feet per season.

Period of use, from April 1st to July 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 21st, 1916

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
