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THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James Ryan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cane Spring Reservoir through said reservoir for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point approximately in the NE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 9 S. R. 64 E, which bears S 28° 30' W, 33880 feet from the SE Cor. Sec. 32, T. 8 S. R. 65 E. MDB&M.

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Ryan

Post-office address Galiente, Lincoln County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 10.0 acre feet of water per annum.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.

Date of priority of appropriation April 28th, 1923.

Description of works and diversion of use:

A reservoir 150 feet long, 40 feet wide and 5 feet deep has been constructed to conserve drainage and run-off water from Cane Spring Valley, for 200 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
