CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS The Adams McGill Company, Inc. has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Virgindale Spring No. 1

through pipeline and troughs for

stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NE SW Sec. 26, T. 12 N.R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., which bears N. 44° 45' E, 2660 feet from the SW Cor. said Sec. 26

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of

1913

has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Adams McGill Company, Inc.,

Post-office address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.025 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from May 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 24th, 1922.

Description of works of diversion and use:--

Water is diverted from the spring and conveyed through 160 feet of 1 inch pipe to 100 feet of 18 inch iron troughs where it is conserved for watering approximately 2500 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
