CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, The Adams McGill Company, Inc., has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Middle Douglas Well

through pump, pipeline and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows at a point in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 10 N.R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, which bears S 87° 30' W, 3320 feet from the NE Cor. said Sec. 25, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Adams McGill Company, Inc.,

Post-office address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.013 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from October 1st to April 1st of each year following.

Date of priority of appropriation October 16th, 1922.

Description of works of diversion and use:- Water is pumped from the well, which is 43 feet deep, by means of a horse power pump, and it is conveyed through 16 feet of 2 inch pipe to 200 feet of iron troughs 20 inches in diameter, where it is used for watering approximately 3000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
