CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. B. Cornell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from White Rock Spring

through a ditch and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NW part SW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 17 N. R. 36 E., which bears N 90° E. 990 feet from the SW cor. said Sec. 28, situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW-YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. B. Cornell

Post-office address: Fallon, Churchill County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.0148 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.

Date of priority of appropriation November 6th, 1922.

Description of works of diversion and use:-

Water is conducted from spring, by means of a small ditch 50 feet long, to a reservoir 40 feet in diameter located within a corral, where it is used for watering approximately 400 head of cattle and 75 head of horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
