CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Rafael Gamboa has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Un-named Well through Pump to tank thence to troughs for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: At a point in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, T. 34 N., R. 56 E., N.E.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Rafael Gamboa

Post-office address Lamoille, Elko County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.015 of a cubic foot of water per second  
April 1st to July 1st

Period of use, from September 15th to November 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 31, 1924

Description of Works of diversion and use:  
Consit of well 40 feet deep by 4 1/2 by 8 feet long metal troughs 65.3 feet long by 1.3 feet wide by 8 inches deep, 2000 gallon metal storage tank, gasoline engine and pump.  
Water is pumped to storage tank thence to watering troughs where it is used for waterin 2000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
