CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E. B. Robison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Line-Rock Spring through galvanized pipe line for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 13N., R. 65E. M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S 56° 0' W., 14965 feet distant from 1/4 Cor. on north boundary of Sec. 5, T. 13 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. B. Robison 1/2 interest, E. B. Robison 1/2 interest.

Post-office address Ely, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 100 cattle or 0.003 C.F.S.

Period of use, from March 15 to November 15 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 30, 1921.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is diverted at the spring by means of a cut, 10' x 12' and water is conveyed through 60' of galvanized pipe to an iron tank 3' wide and 15 feet long, where it is stored for watering of 100 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
