CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Oscar Gerbig has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from A well (Gerbig Well)

through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 81° 30' E., 406 ft. Dist. from 1/4 cor. common to Secs. 28 and 29 T. 6 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M., or in the NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 6 N., R. 31 E.

situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Oscar Gerbig

Post-office address Hawthorne, Mineral County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation Sufficient to water 200 head of cattle or 0.006 C.F.S.

Period of use, from Jan. 1st. to Dec. 31st. of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 22, 1925.

Description of works of diversion and use:—

One drilled well 125 ft. deep, cased with 7 inch steel casing, one steel tower, one wind mill at point above described and water is pumped from well into reservoir 10 feet away. Water is conveyed from reservoir by means of 80 feet of pipe to three watering troughs each 20 feet long, 2 ft. wide and 18 inches deep. The overflow from troughs is saved in a round pond 25 feet in diameter.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
