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**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS Alma Woods has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hill Side Spring through Pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: N. 47° 45' W., 1410 ft. distant from 1/4 Cor. common to Secs. 11 and 12 T. 18 N., R. 49 E., M.D.M. or SE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 18 N., R. 49 E., M.D.M. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alma Woods

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 60 head cattle or 0.002 C.F.S.

Period of use, from April 1st. to Dec. 1st. of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 18, 1925.

Description of works of diversion and use:-
Water at spring developed by digging well 4 x 4 x 10 feet deep. A cut ten feet deep at well allows the water to be conveyed by means of 100 feet of 1/2 in. pipe to trough 14 feet long, 2 feet wide and 18 ins. deep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
