CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. D. McIntosh has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Burke Spring

through ditch for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 88° E. 1040 ft. distant from 1/4 Cor. on West boundary Sec. 6, T. 22 N., R. 65 E., M.D.M. or in the NW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 22 N., R. 65 E., M.D.M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Gertrude Burke

Post-office address McGill, Nevada

Amount of appropriation Sufficient to water 30 head cattle, 6 horses

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 27, 1922

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water developed at spring by means of cuts, 3 ft. wide, 2 to 6 ft. deep and 100 ft. long, and water is diverted and conveyed through cuts to reservoir 10 ft. wide, 80 ft. long, 2 ft. deep, created by a dam, 100 ft. long, 10 ft. wide and 3 ft. high.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
