CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Guiseppe Buralli by R. Parlanti has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pony Meadow Spring

through Pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: N. 72° 37' 30" E. 9029.1 ft. distant from U.S.M.M. No. 1, Palmyra and Indian Spgs. Mining Dist. of in SE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 15 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Guiseppe Buralli

Post-office address Dayton, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.006 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use, from Jan. 1st. to Dec. 31st. of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 20, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted and conveyed from spring by means of 20 ft. of 1' pipe to a reservoir about 10 feet by 10 feet, thence 15 feet of 1' pipe conveys water from trough 1' x 1' x 7' where it is used for watering 200 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
