CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. E. Thornton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through ditch, pipe and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 26° 42' E. 3066.1 ft. distant from Cor. Secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, T. 30 N., R. 35 E., M.D.M. or in NE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 30 N., R. 35 E., M.D.M.

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1915 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. E. Thornton

Post-office address Unionville, Nevada

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 500 head of cattle or 0.0156 C.R.S.

Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 26, 1924.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: -

Water is diverted from springs by means of ditch into reservoir, plank lined 6' x 16' x 3' deep, 68 feet of 1 1/2" pipe conveys water from reservoir into a water trough 2 x 16 x 1' deep, where it is used for watering 500 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
