CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pass Creek Springs

through Reservoirs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 53° 51' E. 13,564 ft. distant from Post No. 1, U. S. Patents Nos. 90 and 91, or approximately SE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 19. N., R. 54. E., M.D.M. unsurveyed.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada:

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1915 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A. C. Florio

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 8000 head of sheep or 0.05 C.F.S.

Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 9, 1924

Description of works of diversion, manner and places of use: Water is diverted and impounded in small reservoirs in main channel of stream by construction of four small earth dams, about 10 ft. long, 4 ft. wide and 2 ft. high.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
