CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

through Ditch for irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 17 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.
