CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Robison

WHEREAS, Geo. S. Robison and Sons, by Orvis C. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lint and Monroe Spring

through pipe line, tank and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 10° W. 7260 ft. distant from South east cor. of Sec. 32, T. 15 N., R. 68 E. M.D.M. or in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 14 N., R. 68 E., M.L.M. unsurveyed.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of

1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Geo. S. Robison & Sons
Post-office address Baker, Nevada

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 1000 head sheep or 0.00625 C.F.S.

Period of use, from May 1st to Sept. 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 28, 1925.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is developed by means of an open cut 40 ft. long and 10 ft. deep at source of water. Water is diverted and conveyed through 40 ft. of 1 1/2 inch pipe to a wooden storage tank having a capacity of 2500 gallons, from which it is emptied directly into a system of iron troughs 60 ft. long for the watering of 1000 sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
