CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Robison

WHEREAS Geo. S. Robison & Sons, by Orvis C. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jack Spring

through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 26° 00' W. 15180 ft. distant from Southeast Cor. Sec. 32, T. 15 N., R. 68 E. M.D.M. or in the NE-1/4 Sec. 18, T. 14 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Geo. S. Robison & Sons.

Post-office address Baker, Nevada

Amount of appropriation Sufficient to water 2000 sheep or 0.0125 C.F.S.

Period of use, from May 1st to Sept. 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 28, 1925.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use :-

Water is developed at source by means of an open cut and diverted directly at the source by means of 70 ft. of 1 1/2 inch pipe, through which water is conveyed to system of galvanized iron troughs 75 ft. long, where it is conserved for watering 2000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
