CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Emil Baumann has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Mud Spring through pipe line and troughs for

Stockwatering purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 24 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Emil Baumann

Post-office address Cortez, via Beowawe, Nevada

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 2500 head of sheep and 250 head of cattle or 0.0254 C.F.S.

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 17, 1924

Description of works of diversion, Manner and place of use:

An excavation 7 x 7 ft. by 4 ft. deep at the source, from which water is diverted and conveyed through 15 ft of 3 inch pipe to 46 ft. of wood and iron troughs, located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, T. 24 N., R. 48 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
