CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ignacio Landa by David Dotta has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from South Fork Humboldt River through Hylton Ditch No. 1 and Hylton Ditch No. 2 for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 32 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72 Chapter 140 Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Ignacio Landa
Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.91 of one cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from April 15th to September 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 26, 1915.
