CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Pete Edera has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Canyon Spring

through Dry Canyon ditch, reservoir & pipe for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 19 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Hunter and Edith May Hunter

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 C.F.S.

Period of use, from April to November of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 30, 1917.

Description of works and diversion:

The water is diverted by Dry Canon ditch 100 feet leading South West to reservoir with 25 feet of one inch pipe leading out of reservoir to watering troughs located in the NW 1/4 Section 3, T. 19 N., R. 54 E., of M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
