Description of Works and diversion:-
The works of diversion consists of a dam and reservoir located about thirty feet north easterly from the spring, and is there used for watering approximately 50 head of cattle and 20 head of horses. The place of use of water is in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, T. 19 N., R. 54 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
