CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. G. Taylor has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Little Hot Spring

through Reservoir and pipeline for

Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 2, T. 3 N., R. 32 E., or at a point N. 68° 54' 40" W., 14,209.5' from the SE corner of Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. G. Taylor

Post-office address Benton, Mono County, California

Amount of appropriation 0.0034 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 2, 1923.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Consist of Reservoir, pipeline and watering troughs where 5 head of cattle, 20 head of horses and 15 mules are watered.

The above described works are located at the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
