CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. H. Reinken has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lamolle Creek

through Reinken's Ditch for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 32, T. 34 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter 18, Statutes of 1907 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Lamolle, Elko County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 1.54 cubic feet of water per second or 466.53 acre feet per season
Period of use, from April 1st to August 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 4, 1912

Description of land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Table with 2 columns: Area and Description. Includes entries for 9.50 acres of Sage and Grain, 27.50 acres Grain, 77.20 acres, 18.50 acres, 21.40 acres Sage and Grain, and a total of 154.10 Acres.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
