

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. H. Bradish has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bradish Spring No. 1

through 36' of 2" pipe to trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 40 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. Or at a point S. 48° 30' E., 720 feet from NW corner of Section 20, T. 40 N., R. 63 E. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James H. Bradish

Post-office address Wells, Elko County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.03125 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle and horses.

Period of use, from April 1st to December 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 27, 1925.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An excavation was made at the spring from which the water is conveyed by 36' of 2" pipe to a trough 14' long, 23" wide and 23" deep where it is used for watering 1000 head of cattle and horses.

The above described works are in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
