

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. H. Bradish has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bradish Spring No. 2 through 60' of 1 1/2" pipe to trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 40 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point S. 64° 15' W., 96,500 feet from the NE corner of Section 32, T. 40 N., R. 63 E., situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. H. Bradish
Post-office address Wells, Elko County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation Q. 03125 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 1000 head
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 12, 1925.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A fenced excavation was made at the spring from which water is diverted through 60' of 1 1/2" pipe to a trough 8' long, 2' 8" wide, and 3' deep where it is used for watering 1000 head of cattle and horses.
The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
