WHEREAS, Chas. W. Williams

has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Ford Spring

through Open Cut and Pipeline

for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Section 31, T. 20 S. R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point N. 45° 27' W. 903 feet from the SE Corner of Section 31, T. 20 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Chas. W. Williams

Post-office address Shoshone, California

Amount of appropriation 0.002 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 21, 1921.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from its source through an open cut 5 feet by 15 feet long and water is conveyed to three 25 gallon, 1/2 barrels or tubs, located at regular intervals, by means of 200 feet of 3/4 inch iron pipe.

The water is used to water 50 head of cattle and 4 horses

The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
