CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Handley Bros., by Walter Handley has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Dry Mountain Well
through Pump and Tank for
Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 19 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed or S. 52° 15' E., 164 chains from the NW corner of Section 31, T. 20 N., R. 57 E.
situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Handley Bros.,
Post-office address Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.031 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.
Period of use, from September 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 6, 1921.

Description of Works of diversion, manuer and place of use:
Well sunk to a depth of 35 feet, and by means of a gasoline engine the water is pumped to a 3000 gallon red wood tank from which water is diverted to 90 feet of iron troughs where it is used to water 5000 head of sheep.

The above works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
