CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ralph H. Olinghouse has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tower's Springs through Pipeline to trough for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW 1/4 Section 14, T. 3 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point S. 25° 41' E., 2413.1 feet from the NW corner of Section 14, T. 3 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Ralph H. Olinghouse
Post-office address Pioche, Lincoln County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.016 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 2, 1924

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Cut 20 feet by 2 feet wide and 60 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe line conveys the water to a trough 1 foot by 1 foot by 10 feet where 500 head of cattle and horses are watered.

The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
