CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ralph Henry Olinghouse has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Board Cabin Spring

through Pipeline to trough for

Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 3 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M. or S. 76 1/2 E., 2373 feet from the West 1/2 corner of Section 10, T. 3 N., R. 68 E.

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Ralph Henry Olinghouse

Post-office address Pioche, Lincoln County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.016 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 30, 1924.

Description of Works of diversion manner and place of use:

Well 4 feet by 4 feet by 6 feet deep; 40 feet of 1 inch pipeline conveys water to trough 1 foot by 1 foot by 10 feet where 500 head of cattle and horses are watered.

The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
