CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. A. Yelland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Coyote Well through pipeline to troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 19 N., R. 69 E., unsurveyed or whence the SE corner of Section 34 T. 21 N., R. 69 E., M.D.M. bears N. 15°30' E., 50,850 feet.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator R. A. Yelland

Post-office address Aurum, White Pine County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 of a cubic foot of water per second of time

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 30, 1924

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

A pump operated by horse power, pumps the water from Coyote Well into a 2 inch by 30 foot pipe line which conveys the water to 60 feet of galvanized troughs where 2000 sheep are watered.

The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
