

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. W. Harton by C. I. Wadsworth has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Granger Spring through Open Cut, tunnel and reservoir for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T. 11 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Ryan of Caliente, Nevada 1/4 undivided interest.
Post office address Gardner Ranch Co., Hiko, Nevada 3/4 undivided interest.
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 8, 1915.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring is developed by means of an open cut 75 feet long leading to a tunnel 100 feet in length. The water is impounded in a reservoir 150 feet long by 25 feet wide and an average depth of 2 feet and there used for watering 400 head of cattle.

The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
