purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Ryan, of Caliente, Nevada, 1/2 undivided interest

Post office address Gardner Ranch Co., Hiko, Nevada, 2/3 undivided interest

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 of a cubic foot of water per second of time

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 8, 1915.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring is developed by an open cut 60 feet long and by a Cross Cut 200 feet long and 8 feet deep. The water is conveyed from the main cut by means of 1 1/2" pipe to troughs used for watering 400 head of cattle.

The above described works are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
