CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. M. Green, President Belle Helen Mines Co. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Strong Spring through 200' 4 3/4" and 9100' 2" pipe to tank for

Mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13, T. 2

N., R. 49 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Belle Helen Merger Mines Company

Post-office address Tonopah, Nye County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0223 C.F.S. or 10 gallons per min.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 18, 1922.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

A concrete dam 8' x 8' x 4' was constructed at the spring from which 200' of 4 3/4" pipe and 9100' of 2" pipe conveys the water to a receiving tank located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 2 N., R. 50 E., where it is used for Mining, Milling and domestic purposes.

The Mill, a 100 ton plant, is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 7, T. 2 N., R. 50 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
