THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Geo. B. Williams has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Park Canon Spring No. 1 through short pipe to troughs for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 17 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Geo. B. Williams
Post-office address: Fallon, Churchill County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0150 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2400 head of sheep
Period of use, from: April 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 14, 1924.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A short pipe line conveys the water from the spring to troughs where it is used for watering 2400 head of sheep.

The above described works are located in the NW 1/4 Section 31, T. 17 N., R. 38 E., unsurveyed, and in the NE 1/4 Section 36, T. 17 N., R. 37 E., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
