CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Geo. B. Williams has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Canon Spring through Dams and catch basins for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 16 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or N. 72 3/4 W., 3640 feet from the SW corner of Section 7, T. 16 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Geo. B. Williams

Post-office address Fallon, Churchill County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0150 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2400 head of sheep.

Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 14, 1924.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Dams and catch basins have been constructed in the SE 1/4 of Section 12, T. 16 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, where water is impounded for the watering of 2400 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
