

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. W. Griswold has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring

through pipe for 50 yards to troughs for Stock watering purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 31 N., R. 63 E. M.D. B&M. situated in ELKO County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Griswold-Henderson Livestock Company

Post-office address Elko, Elko County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2000 head of sheep

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 28, 1920

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is piped from the spring in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 31 N., R. 63 E., to troughs where it is used for watering 2000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
