

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Pres.

WHEREAS, Kent Land & Livestock Co. by C. E. Kent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lower East Lee Canyon Spring through pipe line to troughs for

Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 19 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. (unsurveyed) situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kent Land and Livestock Company
Post-office address Fallon, Churchill County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.037 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 3000 sheep, 1000 cattle, and 100 horses
Period of use, from February 1 to November 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 30, 1925.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the spring in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 19 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. through a 2 inch pipe line 16 ft. long, to six troughs 1 ft. wide 1 ft. deep 14 ft. long where it is used for the watering of 3000 sheep, 1000 head of cattle, and 100 head of horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
