CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS C. R. Moorman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Chalk Spring through pipe line to troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or N. 72 1/2 W., 4350 ft. from SE corner Sec. 1 T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clarence R. Moorman
Post-office address Kimberly, White Pine County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0011 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 35 head of cattle
Period of use, from April 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 1, 1924

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the spring in the NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., through a cut in earth 35 ft. long and 10 ft. in depth at upper end thence through 20 ft. of 2 inch pipe line to a system of 12 inch half round galvanized iron troughs where it is used for the watering of 35 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
