CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Burton H. Robison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring through 90 feet of 3 inch pipe line for Stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 24 T 25 N. R 65 E. M. D. B. & M. or N 26° W 1312 feet from the S 1/4 corner of Sec. 24 T. 25 N., R. 65 E., M. D. M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Burton H. Robison
Post-office address Aurum, White Pine County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1500 head of sheep.
Period of use, from April 1 to October 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 19, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An open cut 120 feet long and 3 feet deep was made at the spring in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 24 T 25 N. R. 65 E., M. D. M., from where water is conveyed through 90 feet of 3 inch pipe to a set of galvanized iron troughs, 50 feet in length and having a capacity of 8 gallons per foot, where it is used for the watering of 1500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
