CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Burton H. Robison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

through Ditch for Stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 10 T 25 N. R. 66 E., M. D. B. & M. Or N. 9° W 771 feet from the SE corner
Sec. 10 T 25 N. R 66 E., M.
situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 1500 head of sheep.
Period of use, from May 1 to October 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 5, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use.
An open ditch 50 feet long conveys the water from the spring
in the SE 1/4 Sec. 10. T 25 N R 66 E., M. D. B. & M. to an earthen
reservoir 75 feet long and 4 feet deep where it is used for the
watering of 1500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
