Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use,  
An earthen dam 8 feet long, 5 feet wide, and 2 feet high has been constructed at Gibellini Spring No. 2, and an earthen dam 6 feet long 5 feet wide, and 2 feet high has been constructed Gibellini Spring No. 3 from which 15 feet of 1 inch pipe conveys water to a tank 30 inches diameter and 30 inches high. These works facilitate the watering of 8000 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle and are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
