CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS H. M. Payne for A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hash Spring

through pipe line and trough for Stock watering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 26 T 21 N. R. 52 E. M. D. B. & M. unsurveyed or S 63° 40' W 54,800 Ft. from the NE Cor Sec. 5 T 21 N. R. 54 E. M. D. B. & M. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.059 c.f.s. of sufficient to water 8000 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation June 20, 1927

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use,  
An earthen dam 40 feet long, 10 feet wide, and 4 feet high was constructed at the spring in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 26 T 21 N. R 52 E., M D B & M. from where water is conveyed through 40 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to two troughs, one trough being 1 foot wide and the other 1 1/2 feet wide and both 1 foot high and 16 feet long.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
