WHEREAS: H. M. Payne for A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____ Railroad Spring _____ through _____ pipe line and reservoir _____ for _____ Stock watering and domestic _____

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE¹ SE¹ Sec. 26 T 21 N. R. 52 E. M. D. B. & M. unsurveyed or S. 62 20' W. 55,040 feet from NE. cor. Sec. 26 T 21 N. R. 54 E. M. D. B. & M. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of _____ 1913 _____ has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A. C. Florio
Post-office address Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation sufficient to water 8000 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 20, 1927

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
An earthen dam 20 feet long, 7 feet wide, and 3 feet high was constructed near the spring in the SE¹ SE¹ Sec. 26 T 21 N. R. 52 E., from where water is conveyed through 30 feet of 1 inch pipe to a reservoir where it is used for the watering of 8000 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
