CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS L. A. McCulley has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Spring through pipe line and troughs for Stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 6 T. 42 N. R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M. or N 84 E 1500 ft from the W 1/4 cor Sec 6 T 42 N. R. 23 E T. E. & M. Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2000 sheep
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1926

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
An excavation was made at the spring in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec 6 T. 42 N. R. 23 E., from where 16 feet of 1 inch pipe conveys the water to 90 feet of stock troughs where it is used for the watering of 2000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
