

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS L. A. McCulley has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Scrip or Nut Spring

through reservoirs for stock watering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12 T 42 N. R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M. or S 14° 54' W 8090 Ft from the 1/2 cor common to Secs 1 and 2 T 42 N. R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisors of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator L. A. McCulley

Post-office address Cedarville, Modoc County, California

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of sheep.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1926

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Three small reservoirs were constructed immediately below the spring in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12 T 42 N. R. 22 E., M.D.B. where water is impounded for the watering of 2000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
