CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Uhalde has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gulch Spring through Pipe line to troughs for Stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9 T 19 N. R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John Uhalde  
Post-office address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 5000 head of sheep.  
Period of use, from March 1st to October 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation July 26, 1920

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
An earth and rock dam 30 feet long, 15 feet wide, and 3 feet deep was constructed at the spring in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 9 T 19 N. R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M. from where water is conveyed through 30 feet of 2 inch pipe to 3 galvanized troughs 12 feet long, 16 inches wide, and 8 inches deep where it is used for the watering of 5000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
