CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John Uhalde has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Uhalde Well through Pump, pipe and troughs for Stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 7 T. 21 N. R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M. unsurveyed, or N 4° 03' E., 57,670 feet from the SW cor. T. 20 N. R. 61 E., M. D. B. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1915 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John Uhalde  
Post-office address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation to water 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient 2500 head of sheep.  
Period of use, from April 1st to November 30 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1921

Description of Works of diversion manner and place of use:  
A two inch pump run by horse power was installed at the well which is 4 x 4 ft. by 79 ft. deep, from which water is conveyed through 20 feet of 2 inch pipe to 100 feet of iron troughs where it is used for the watering of 2500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
