CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Paul H. Dory has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rye Patch Springs through pipe line to troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36 T 20 N. R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M. or S 21° 45' E. 31,330 ft. from the south 1/4 cor. of Sec. 34 T 21 N. R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Paul H. Dory

Post-office address Austin, Lander County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.003125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle.

Period of use, from March 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 12, 1918

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is conveyed through an iron pipe 20 ft long to a wooden trough 14' x 2' x 1' from which the overflow is impounded in three earthen dams or catch basins and used for watering 100 head of stock.

The place of use is in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
