CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mrs. Eliza McAfee by J. D. Callahan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Charles Canyon Spring through 12 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to trough for Stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 16 T. 21 N. R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M. or N. 83 45' W. 4527 feet from the SE corner Sec. 16 situated in LANDER County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Mrs. Eliza McAfee  
Post-office address Austin, Lander County, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0022 c.f.s. or sufficient to water seventy head of cattle.  
Period of use, from April 1st to September 30 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 11, 1923

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Twelve feet of one and one half inch pipe conveys the water from the spring in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 16 T. 21 N. R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M., to a galvanized iron trough fifty inches long, twenty-one inches wide and two feet deep where it is used for the watering of seventy head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
