CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. M. Ward and J. H. Smith, by J. H. Smith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Cottonwood Springs

through 10 feet of pipe to troughs for

stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 34 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or N. 22 1/2 W., 2675 feet from the SE corner Sec. 31, T. 34 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.009 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 6, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Ten feet of galvanized pipe conveys water from the spring located in the NE 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 34 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., to a galvanized iron trough 24 inches by 14 inches by 10 feet long where it is used for the watering of 300 head of cattle and horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
